Confirmation of Registration:

Once we receive your registration form and payment (payable to Pride Durham Inc. or via PayPal at (www.pridedurham.com) you will receive a confirmation via email. This confirmation will give you details on when and where to arrive on Parade day and other important information. Below is a list of basic rules for the parade. Pride Durham reserves the right to allow or disallow any group applying for participation in the parade.

Rules and Regulations:

1. No open flames on floats or held by marchers.
2. All floats must have safety rails and harnessed for riders. Flatbeds must have decorative skirts, no sharp edges or nails sticking out and all drivers must be licensed to drive the vehicle they are operation. Floats and licenses will be inspected before the parade in the Marshaling area.
3. Parade participants are not allowed to throw anything into the crowd during the parade.
4. If you are using a generator is must be secured to the vehicle, have adequate ventilation (3 feet on every side, and no person shall be seated within 5 feet of the generator.
5. There is ABSOLUTLY NO STOPPING DURING THE PARADE. With the exception of the motorcycles at the beginning of the Parade.
6. No public nudity will be permitted in the parade in accordance with section 174 of the Criminal Code.
7. All animals must be parade broken and leashed at all times.
8. Each group must designate one member as it's parade marshal.
9. Groups shall follow directions given by police, parade coordinator and parade marshals.
